

Where is the focus?

True worshipers stay in the right line moving towards the goal. They don't try to become the goal. Their (my) usability is only meant to point the way to the goal not become it instead. It's OK to be seen as long as it serves only to point the way. When all eyes are focused on You we are all in unison together. Lines start for a purpose and everyone joining that line is there for the same purpose. The people in the line don't make the reason for the line. The reason exists and people join the line to become part of its process. By waiting in a specific line you expect/anticipate a specific outcome. (You don't join the line waiting for the bathroom in hopes of getting something to eat.) The line is living and changing. The one in front of you follows the one in front of him who follows... The one in the front of the line is only there because he followed some one else to that spot for the same reasons. The one at the front receives his service and then moves on to make room for the next one. He doesn't stand at the front pretending to be the reason for the line, nor does he look to anyone else in line to fulfill his need. The ones in front point the way to the purpose and give direction to those following. They are not the purpose themselves but by being a part of the line help others follow its progress and path. (Some heads are easier to see in line and people chart their progress by measuring the progress of the one they are watching. This doesn't make the one being followed the purpose but helps to keep the other in the right line and moving towards the right goal.)
